SUMMER CONCERT AND CONCESSION PROGRAM 2025 RECAP

78 families worked 75 concerts in total

Commissions and tips averaged \$250/person per event

Teams Elite families made over \$300,000 in concert and concession fundraising

- \$12,776.90 to TE fundraising account
- \$300,140.19 credited to individual skater accounts for payment

EVENT ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Roles:

- Stand Lead
- Register
- Bartender
- Cook/Food preparation
- Runner

Responsibilities (general)

- Perform inventory counts at start and end of shift
- Food preparation, cooking
- Stocking and restocking product
- Serve customers food and drinks
- Mix and pour drinks
- Operate point-of-sale devices to ring customers out
- Clean up



ELIGIBILITY

Teams Elite parents, siblings, and skaters

Skaters <18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent

Age minimums vary by venue (16 to 21 for food/alcohol service)

Participants must sign and comply with the Teams Elite Concert and Concession Fundraising Program Policy

All training and certifications must be completed prior to signing up for an event



REQUIRED TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION

Required Certification (IL)

- Basset Alcohol Certification License (21 and over)

 - Valid for 3 years

- CU1 Amphitheater requires onsite training
 - New volunteers only
 - May 4, 2026 @ 6pm (2 hours)

Required Certification (IN)

- Indiana Server Training Certificate
- Volunteer Employee Permit

DRESS CODE AND OTHER SUGGESTED ITEMS

Dress code varies by venue

- ❑ All volunteers must purchase and wear an official Teams Elite shirt via the TE volunteer store
 - ❑ <https://bsnteamssports.com/shop/apByHwdrhg>
- ❑ Some sites provide a venue polo/uniform
- ❑ Most sites require black pants or shorts
 - ❑ No yoga pants, leggings or pants with holes
- ❑ Black non-slip shoes are required
 - ❑ Many brands make non-slip shoes for work; all okay, just ensure non-slip

HOW TO SIGN UP

Monthly Google forms

TeamSnap will be created for event with volunteer assignments and waitlist

Cancellations are allowed up to 3 weeks before the event

- ❑ To cancel, complete the cancellation form
- ❑ If the event is less than 3 weeks away, you are responsible for finding a replacement
- ❑ Start with the TeamSnap waitlist first
- ❑ Replacement must be part of the concert and concession group
- ❑ No show penalty is \$250

Sometimes the venue cancels or cuts the number of volunteers needed for an event

- ❑ If cuts are needed, we will ask for volunteers, followed by one volunteer per family, then random cuts



FUND MANAGEMENT, TIPS, AND SHARES

Fund management

Commissions

- 90% to skater accounts
- 10% to TE fundraising

Tips

- Cash – split evening at the end of the shift among all volunteers
- Credit card – 100% to skater accounts (included in share calculations)

Share system (venue-based)

- One shift = one share
- Final payout = (personal share/total shares) x payout
- Shares are calculated on a per venue basis and are listed in the policy
- Summerfest requires additional insurance (cost shared by all Summerfest workers; deducted from account [typically \$10-15])
- Michaels Catering funds calculated by hourly wage and combined tips

FUND ALLOCATION

- ❑ To use funds, you must email Evette (treasurer) and let her know how you would like to use the funds (eg, Please apply \$X from my concert fundraising to my skater's monthly fees.)
- ❑ Siblings may share funds
- ❑ Balances may NOT transfer to other families
- ❑ Any unused fundraising balances will automatically roll over to the following season, provided the skater remains an active member of TE
- ❑ Any unused funds will roll over to the general TE fundraising account

NEXT STEPS

STEP 1: Review the TE Concert and Concessions Policy 2026-2027

STEP 2: Complete the TE Concert and Concessions Policy Agreement 2026-2027 for each volunteer by May 1, 2026; you will then be added to the TeamSnap group

STEP 3: Complete all necessary training and certification and email certification/training certificate copies to fundraising@teamselite.com

STEP 4: All new workers must attend the Legends training on April 27, 2026 at 6 pm at Credit Union 1 Amphitheater in Tinley Park, IL
